### TOBACCO- AND ALCOHOL-FREE SCHOOLS

#### I. PURPOSE

To implement LCPS Policy ADC: Tobacco- and Alcohol-Free Schools.

#### II. POSITION

- A. The ban on the use or possession of tobacco products on school district property shall include all lighted smoking equipment or material, with or without nicotine, including but not limited to electronic, also known as e-cigarettes, vapor cigarettes or e-cigs, or any other electrical inhaler that simulates the act of tobacco smoking.
- B. School district employees who violate LCPS Policy ADC: Tobacco- and Alcohol-Free Schools, shall be subject to further disciplinary action as deemed appropriate by their immediate supervisors and/or the superintendent of schools.
- C. Students who violate this policy and related policies shall be subject to the disciplinary actions outlined in LCPS Policy and Regulation JICH: Alcohol, Tobacco and Other Drugs. Student athletes who violate the LCPS student Extracurricular Code of Conduct and all applicable LCPS policies, shall be subject to penalties as outlined in the LCPS Athletics Handbook.
