Students can self-nominate or be nominated by peers, staff or community members. Students eligible to serve are freshmen, sophomores, juniors or seniors in good standing with GPA minimum of 2.0. Students may serve up to four academic years.

Students shall verify with the school principal on the deadline for submitting this Declaration of Interest form.

- I shall provide the Principal with letters of personal reference from teachers, counselors, civic leaders or others; and,
- I will attach a **Letter of Interest** to this Declaration to support my nomination.
