REPORTING ACTS OF VIOLENCE, VANDALISM

I. PURPOSE

In compliance with New Mexico State law (22-10A-33 NMSA), the Las Cruces Public Schools Board of Education supports and encourages the reporting of all acts of violence and vandalism upon or against Las Cruces Public Schools employees and property.

II. POSITION

The Board of Education is committed to the protection of its students, employees and property. The full and timely reporting by school district employees of any and all acts of violence and vandalism upon or against school district employees and property is a vital part of that effort.

III. PROCESS

The Superintendent of Schools shall promulgate and enforce a regulation and guidelines regarding the reporting by LCPS employees of such acts of violence and vandalism.

IV. REVIEW

This policy shall be reviewed on an ongoing basis in accordance with the Board of Education policy review process.
