## ACTIVITY (ANCILLARY) BUSES / SPECIAL EVENTS TRANSPORTATION

#### I. PURPOSE

To provide for the safe transportation of students for academic field trips and other extracurricular activities and to comply with federal and state laws.

#### II. BACKGROUND

The Board of Education believes that field trips, extracurricular activities, interscholastic sports and outdoor education experiences can benefit a student's educational program. School bus transportation may be necessary for teachers and students to attend such events and, therefore, is included as an extension of the classroom.

#### III. POSITION

- A. The district shall develop a contract for activity (ancillary) bus transportation in addition to its daily fleet service bus contract. Such contracts shall be approved by the Board of Education annually.
- B. Students, parents, and chaperones shall follow all rules and regulations for field trips as outlined in Policy IJOA and IJOA-R, Field Trips and Excursions.
- C. The Principal or his/her designee shall be responsible for the behavior of students on the bus during a field trip. Student behavior on a bus shall follow the established procedures as outlined in Policy JI and JI-R, Student Rights and Responsibilities.
- D. The district shall establish procedures for personnel requesting activity (ancillary) buses.
- E. The use of school-owned vehicles other than school buses to transport students to and from school-sponsored activities shall be in compliance with state law and school district policy EEB Business and Personnel Transportation.
- F. The Superintendent shall promulgate a regulation for the enforcement of this policy.

### IV. REVIEW

This policy shall be reviewed on an ongoing basis in accordance with the Board of Education policy review process.
