Uniformly Dressed

I. PURPOSE

The Board of Education supports individual school campuses having flexibility to make recommendations concerning school uniformly dressed programs.

II. GUIDELINES

- A. A uniformly dressed program shall be implemented at, or removed from, individual schools following an election of parents. Schools holding an election to establish or remove a uniformly dressed program will provide adequate notice as to when the election will take place. In addition, parents and students also will be reminded about the date of the election, on a regular basis, until the election is held. A simple majority of 51% will be necessary to determine the outcome of the election.
- B. Specific attire is to be determined cooperatively with the principal and school community.

III. EXCEPTIONS

Students may be exempted from compliance by providing documented religious clothing requirements.

IV. REVIEW AND REPORTING

This policy will be reviewed in accordance with the Board of Education policy review process
