Business Solicitations In Schools

I. PURPOSE

To limit distractions to the educational process from direct marketing or promotion of goods and services for sale to employees or students.

II. POSITION


- A. The Board of Education protects the value of instructional time and the employee work day. Therefore, sales and solicitation from businesses at school and work sites must be authorized and subject to regulation promulgated by the school district.
- B. Soliciting and selling on school property shall be only for purposes of school-related business or Board-authorized employee benefit programs.
- C. Sales and solicitation on school grounds must be approved by an authorized administrator in conjunction with the Superintendent or his designee.
- D. District regulation pertaining to sales and solicitations in schools shall establish reasonable, fair and equally applied limitations and restrictions on the number, timing and extent of any such solicitations such as to limit disruptions to employees and students.

III. REVIEW

This policy shall be reviewed on an ongoing basis in accordance with the Board of Education policy review process.
